Atlantic Director's Walk 11 Km

Rating 1B Wheelchair accessible

Trans Canada Trail Walk

This walk begins at the parking lot of the Dr. Walter Chestnut Public Library on Main Street. Take Exit 172 from the Trans Canada Highway into Hartland. Turn right on Bridge Hill Road and drive through the Covered Bridge. Turn left to the parking lot before the library on your left. ***Please Note:*** The library is a Start Point on the map only. There is no "Walk Box" or information at this establishment.

1. From Dr. Walter Chestnut Public Library parking lot cross Main Street at the pedestrian crosswalk and turn right. Follow Main St out to Cloverdale Road. (The river will be on your right; see how the water sparkles!) You will pass the Water Treatment Plant on your left just before Cloverdale. (1.7 km)
2. Turn left on Cloverdale for a very short distance. Turn left onto the New Brunswick Trail (old rail bed); this is also part of the Trans Canada Trail system. Follow the trail back towards town. You will take the trail through the town crossing McMullin, Queen, Orser and Maple, keeping the river on your left hand side. (3,7 km)
3. Continue on the trail until it crosses Main Street. Cross at the crosswalk and continue on the trail out of town towards Florenceville. Keep the river on your left. Follow the trail under the Hugh John Flemming Bridge (Trans Canada Highway) and continue on the trail until it crosses a driveway. It will be the first house on the left, #7159, Route 105. This is your turn around point. (6.4 km)
4. Turn around and, keeping the river on your right follow the trail back into town. Cross over Main Street and continue on the trail just past Orser to The Courtyard (A variety of unique shops). Turn right and follow through the courtyard to Main Street. The Bridge should be straight ahead of you. (9.6 km)
5. At the crosswalk, cross over Main Street and take the walkway across the Hartland Bridge. (You have just crossed the Longest Covered Bridge in the World). Once on the other side of the bridge turn around and follow the walkway back to Main Street and the Library parking lot. (10.6 km)

We hope you have enjoyed your walk in Hartland.
