The Federation encourages and recognizes outstanding contributions made to Volkssport throughout Canada. This recognition is achieved through a system of national awards. The guidelines for national awards are shown below:

Recognition of exceptional contributions by Volkssporters to the Canadian Volkssport Federation /La Fédération canadienne volkssport

- 1) Forms of honouring Volkssporters:
 - a) Letter of appreciation from the President of the Federation may be awarded
 - b) National Merit Awards for 5, 10, 15, 20 and 25 years of ongoing and exceptional service may be awarded
- 2) Persons to be honoured:
 - a) Officials on the Federation Board and Executive Committees may be nominated
 - b) Officials serving at the regional level may be nominated
 - c) Persons who have served at the local club level may be nominated
- 3) Conditions for the honouring:
 - a) Many years of exceptional and ongoing service to the Federation, a Regional Association or a club are required, but need not be continuous.
 - b) Exceptional contribution to the Federation on a short term basis [President's letter] may be honoured
- 4) Right to nominate:
 - a) Federation Board and Executive Committee members may make nominations
 - b) Regional Association and regular club officials may make nominations
- 5) Application procedure:
 - a) Written nominations are made to the Federation President through the appropriate Regional Director
- 6) Approval of honouring:
 - a) Nominees will be approved by the Federation Board of Directors
- 7) Performance of honouring:
 - a) The presentation of the award will be performed by the President at the Annual General Meeting or by Regional Directors at the regional / club level at the next available opportunity.
